



## The Brighton Collaboration Foundation

The **Brighton Collaboration Foundation (BCF)** is a constitutional partner of the Brighton Collaboration and serves as its organiser and focal point, legal representative and administrative body. The Foundation was founded by the University Children's Hospital Basel, Switzerland in November 2003. It is governed by its Board of Directors and advised by its Scientific Advisory Committee (Science Board). BCF is registered in the commercial register of the Canton Basel City (CH- 270.7.002.873-2) as a tax-exempt public charity. The accounting standards of the Brighton Collaboration Foundation comply with the Swiss Generally Accepted Accounting Principles for small non-profit organisations (Swiss GAAP FER 21) and the applicable Swiss Laws for non-profit organisations. The BCF does not advocate for specific vaccines and is not sponsored by respective vaccine manufacturers.

The BCF maintains and develops the online platform and informs about current activities, projects and their success through regular publications and updates. Under the supervision of the Foundation Board, the Management Team performs all day-to-day management of the Collaboration and its activities.

The Foundation Board creates strategies that help donors and scientists achieve common goals by:

- Connecting outside partners with the Collaboration's scientists.
- Setting policies and guiding the organisational direction.
- Reviewing and approving the Collaboration's programmes.
- Evaluating and guiding the Collaboration's performance.
- Reviewing compliance with relevant material laws.

The Foundation is dedicated to fostering the attainment of the Collaboration's vision.
